Together, we have already achieved so much during this church year: we have hired a new

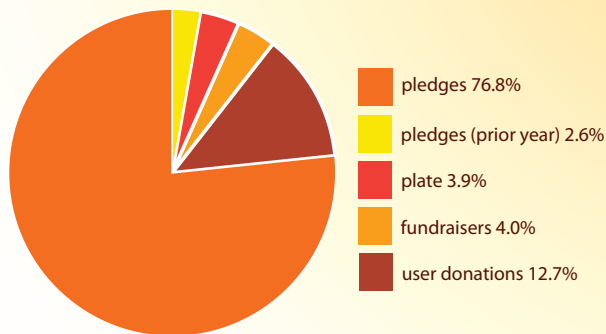
office manager, held a spiritual retreat, hosted a social justice fair, and increased our contributions to the church offering so we can support local charities.
