

What is pledging?

- Pledging is when you declare and record how much you intend to give in the upcoming church year (July 2025 – June 2026).
- Giving is when you fulfill your pledge. For example, by paying monthly throughout the year or all at once at the beginning of the year.

Why pledge in advance and not just give?

- Pledging allows the church to create a balanced budget in advance so our expenses don't exceed our income.
- During the year, the Treasurer and Parish Committee compare the budget with the actual income and expenses to keep us on track.

How do you pledge?
